ANNUAL REPORT 2001-2002

Our Samithi founded with the inspiration of Swamis of the Ramakrishna Order continued its multifarious activities during the present year.

We present hereunder the various activities undertaken on several fronts in the following order:

1. Spiritual activities; 2. Youth Activities; 3. Publication of Books; 4. Children's activities; 5. Other service activities;

Daily Prayer meeting was held on all days throughout the year. Simple morning puja was also conducted throughout the year. All the other important celebrations like Sri Rama Navami, Krishna Ashtami, Vinayaka Chaviti, Siva Ratri Christmas Eve were conducted in the Samithi with Puja in the morning and special Bhajan in the evening.
